Overview

Community Lodgings is an Alexandria, VA-based nonprofit organization with a mission to lift families from homelessness and instability to independence and self-sufficiency. Our Boys' and Girls' Mentoring Programs currently enrich the lives of over 20 homeless and low-income students on a weekly basis. To promote positive youth development, we work with children in grades 6-12 to help them meet program goals.

Purpose

Our mission is to provide a long-term, structured relationship to increase the program participants' self-esteem and ability to trust others. Both the girls' and boys' programs focus on building relationships, all while in a group setting.

- Expose the mentees to different experiences and people to increase awareness of choices available.
- Build self-esteem to promote confidence in the mentees' abilities to make responsible choices.
- Build trusting relationships.
- Help mentees become engaged and responsible citizens through participating in community service work.
